After Action Review

- 1. Registration
 - a. Was well-organized and efficient;
 - b. Some of the paperwork was redundant, need to condense forms and share information between the Band Director and the Booster Club;
 - c. Membership was not high for Booster Club; we need to specify that the \$10 membership fee helps pay for band expenses;
 - d. Pay Pal lessons
 - e. Would be helpful to offer a different time slot on the second day
 - f. Would be helpful to have more samples of each uniform size to avoid waiting and long lines
 - q. When writing in shoe size, make sure the student includes Men/Women sizing
- 2. Hot Dog Howdy
 - a. Huge Success!
 - b. Try to highlight Spirit Shop more and have more inventory for that evening
 - c. Having Mr. Martindale attend was very important
 - d. Jacqee will be checking with HEB to see if we can list them as a sponsor on our website for their inkind donation to Hot Dog Howdy
- 3. Communication
 - a. We need to change the booster email address so that it isn't so similar to the Band Directors email address. Cody will change it to reflect "Boosters"
 - b. Some parents still are not receiving Booster emails. We need to share email addresses with webmaster to see if we can reach everyone; also need to check with Dell to see if he still has some Membership Forms that have that information.

Game Day Preparations

- We are going to buy snacks and drinks for the entire season and keep it at the band hall
- Chaperones will be responsible for distributing snacks/drinks for each game
- Buy coolers and label them with CSCBB
- Make sure parents know that pizza on away-game days does not include drinks

<u>Fundraising</u> – Megan Reynolds

- Coupon Books: still missing 30 books; we will send personal emails to these parents to remind them to return the books as it will cost the club approximately \$450 for those books;
- Spirit Shop We have placed our last Spirit Shop order, until we receive more orders and/or can afford to hold inventory;
- The Cougar Club is allowing us to sell items in the concessions Megan will send out a sign-up sheet for volunteers to help with selling band items; [Tiana Okonkwo offered the use of her Jooners account]
- Advertisements:
 - a. There were 5 sponsors for the Genesis shirts
 - b. We currently have 2 sponsors on the website;
- Restaurant Spirit Nights
 - a. Spoons not much success, may have been too early
 - b. Chick-Fil-A is coming up, Ceci Matthews will be sending out information on date/time
- Aggie Flags: Routes are assigned; has been a little confusing for parents this year many people have been confused about who was selling Aggie Flags and whether or not our band members could receive credit; we need to establish an Aggie Flag committee in the Spring to be proactive in getting involved
- Drive Thru Dinner Plates: Providing a BBQ dinner plate or something similar on a game night that people can drive up to and pick up; One parent suggested also doing it on another night of the week; Megan is going to check with Martindale on if this is possible or not
- Program Sales: Dennis has a sign-up sheet; we need 2 parents and 3 kids for each game that we are responsible for; we will receive \$.75 for each program sold this season

Uniform Chairperson – Susan Roberman:

• Expecting uniforms to arrive late September; Mr. Eaks will try to get fittings done during class time; We are waiting for them to arrive before we schedule volunteers to help with the fittings

Chaperone Chairperson– Leigh Neaves:

- Still need parents to sign up for the October games and help with chaperoning, especially men to help move large equipment [Another suggestion to use Jooners for this]
- Mr. Eaks will establish that girls and boys may not sit together on the bus ride to and from away games
- Home game chaperones need to keep non-band students out of the band area
