1. Call to Order - Markus Nimocks @ 7:04pm
2. Review and Approval of May minutes -

3. Financial Report
  - a. Treasurer's Report - Jon Diamond reviewed the financial statement.
  - b. Budget Matters - we are still under budget for marching show. Hot dog howdy also came in below budget (almost \$1,000) due to lots of hot dog donations.
  - c. Fundraising Income Status - Marchathon net income is over \$25,000. We have not received the check from Snap Raise yet, but it should be here by next month.
