Home Games

- Chaperones Needed: 1 lead chaperone plus 7 chaperones
- Chaperones should wear a CSHS Band Shirt, preferably the chaperone polo, plus a lanyard that will be provided at each game.
- Individuals are limited to chaperone two home games per season to allow for more parents to participate.
- Individuals who would like to chaperone additional games or are willing to step in a substitutes when needed should sign up for the Home Game Chaperone Substitute list during registration or contact one of the lead chaperones.
- Responsibilities:
 - Chaperones should be ready and willing to step in with any task assigned by the lead chaperone or the CSHS staff.
 - Chaperones will arrive by call time for the band and will walk to the stadium with the band.
 - Chaperones will help move any equipment needed (pit equipment, speakers, etc).
 - Chaperones will escort band members to the restroom; chaperones should wait outside the restroom and can hold uniform jackets or any other equipment as needed; the gender of the chaperone or the band member does not impact who can escort.
 - Chaperones will assist with 3rd quarter snack clean up by collecting trash.
 - Prior to halftime preparation, chaperones will be asked to distribute plumes (5 needed) or will sit in the stands to help monitor personal property of the band members (3 needed).
 - Chaperones may watch the performance from the sidelines, but should be ready to assist with any last minute preparations that may be needed.
 - At the end of the game chaperones will carry back the drink coolers and put them up in the band hall.
 - The lead chaperone will have a backpack with basic first aid and will make sure all chaperones know where the bag will be stored.

Away Games and Marching Contests

- Chaperones Needed: 1 lead chaperone plus 14 chaperones
- Chaperones should wear a CSHS Band Shirt, preferably the chaperone polo, plus a lanyard that will be provided at each game.
- In order to serve as an away game chaperone, individuals must have chaperoned at least two home games within the past year.
- Individuals who would like to chaperone additional games or are willing to step in a substitutes when needed should sign up for the Away Game/Marching Contest Chaperone Substitute list during registration or contact one of the lead chaperones.

- Responsibilities:
 - Chaperones should be ready and willing to step in with any task assigned by the lead chaperone or the CSHS staff.
 - Chaperones will arrive by call time for the band and ride the bus with the band. Two chaperones will be assigned to each bus.
 - Chaperones should call role every time students get on and off the bus.
 - Chaperones will help ensure uniforms are put on properly and that they are hung up properly at the end of the game/marching contest.
 - Chaperones will help move any equipment needed (pit equipment, speakers, etc).
 - Chaperones will escort band members to the restroom; chaperones should wait outside the restroom and can hold uniform jackets or any other equipment as needed; the gender of the chaperone or the band member does not impact who can escort.
 - Chaperones will assist with 3rd quarter snack clean up by collecting trash.
 - Prior to halftime preparation or contest preparation, chaperones will be asked to distribute plumes (5 needed) or will sit in the stands to help monitor personal property of the band members (3 needed).
 - Chaperones may watch the performance from the sidelines, but should be ready to assist with any last minute preparations that may be needed.
 - At the end of the game chaperones will carry back the drink coolers and put them on the bus and then return them to the band hall upon arrival.
 - The lead chaperone will have a backpack with basic first aid and will make sure all chaperones know where the bag will be stored.
