Interested candidates should return the completed scholarship application to the CSHS Counseling office – Attn: Ms. Jeanna Knott, no later than Friday, April 28th, 2023 at 4:00 p.m. No late applications will be accepted. We hope you will take advantage of this opportunity!

COLLEGE STATION COUGAR BAND BOOSTER SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Purpose: To recognize outstanding members of the College Station High School Band and Guard

Eligibility:

- Must be in good standing at College Station High School and the band and guard organization.
- Must have made positive contributions to the organization.
- Must be a graduating senior entering a college or university for the following school year.
- Must have been accepted to the college or university of his/her choice as a full-time student.
- Must have been a band or guard student for at least four semesters and be currently enrolled at the time of application submission.
- Must have completely filled out the confidential CSCBB Scholarship application and submitted to the CSHS Counseling office by the deadline - Friday, April 28th, 2023 by 4:00 p.m.

Scholarship:

- The amount of each scholarship is \$1,000.
- Payment will only be made to the institution of higher education of the student.
- Consideration will be based on the student's fine arts accomplishments, band and guard program activity and commitment.
- No consideration will be based on the college or university that the applicant will be attending.
- The recipients will be chosen by independent persons with the process facilitated by the CSCBB Scholarship Committee.
- The scholarships will be awarded at the Band Banquet.
- Scholarships must be used within one year of award.

CSCBB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria:

Review the criteria enclosed to be sure you meet the qualifications to apply.

Band and Guard Participation:

Place an 'X' in the associated cell for each activity for each year that you participated. Participation in band or guard at your former high school is eligible if you were a transfer student.

Leadership:

List all band / guard leadership positions held for each year.

Musical Accomplishments (Band Only):

List 'Auditioned' or 'Selected' for each applicable item for the associated year. Include being selected as an alternate.

Activities Attended for Band and Guard, Individual Participation Only.

Please note: You have been scored already for participation in the *Groups* listed in the "Band and Guard Participation" section (Marching, Concert, Symphonic, Guard, etc.) This section is for *Individual* Participation. It gives you the opportunity to show how you have used your talents outside of band and guard class/concerts/competitions.

Fine Arts Participation - Not restricted to College Station High School

* Not restricted to College Station High School means that, in addition to College Station High School Fine Arts participation, this section can include community, church, or another related area.

Include:

- o Years of lessons and what you studied
- Instrumentation or participation in the performance arts (list the plays and locations if other than College Station)
- Other Fine Arts activities such as composition or choreography

Voluntary Student Service for Band & Guard:

List each fundraiser that you participated in each season. (Example: DAtB/fall, TCGC/spring, etc.)

Include:

Fundraisers that contribute to the entire band and guard, percussion ensemble, jazz band, etc. Or use activities that contribute to a collective fund for "students in need" to attend a specific event.

Do Not Include:

March-a-Thon/Hot Dog Howdy participation or anything that you are <u>required</u> to participate in as a member of our band and guard.
